Our Moonshot


We will implement a collaborative system that results in the prevention and resolution of homelessness and racial inequities, giving power to those who are seeking shelter, safety, and employment.








Disparity in Civil Service Salary

"Highest Proportion of Non-White Employees was \$40,000 and below"







California homeless population is about 27 percent of the total homeless population in the nation.


California's overall population is about 12 percent of the nation.


